* Entry is open, regardless of age or ability but entrants must reside or work in the Shoalhaven, Kiama, Southern Highlands or Eurobodalla Local Government Areas (LGAs).

Any visual arts medium is accepted for this competition. For example:

- Traditional Media: that is oil, acrylic, charcoal, pen and ink, watercolour, pastel – Must be framed with D rings, 15 kilograms limit, and within 1 metre square. NO diptychs or triptyches will be accepted.
- Mixed Media: that is oil, acrylic, charcoal, pen and ink, watercolour, pastel
 Must be framed with D rings, 15 kilograms limit, and within 1 metre square. NO diptychs or triptyches will be accepted.
- Digital Media that is one photograph, a video, etcetera;
- 3D work: A sculpture: clay or wood etc must be less than 15 kilograms and within 1 Metre square in any direction.

Conditions of Entry 2023

Entrants	Open entry to all those who reside or work in the following geographical areas: Shoalhaven, Kiama, Southern Highlands or Eurobodalla Local Government Areas (LGAs). Entrants do not have to have a mental illness to enter and can be of any age.

Number of Entries	Only one entry permitted per person. Must be original work and not previously been exhibited in any Mental Health Exhibition.
Entry fees	Entry fee is \$10 per person. Limit of 1 work to be entered per person.
Framing and Hanging Artwork requirements	Your entry must be ready for hanging or display. A wet painting or unsafe work will NOT be accepted. Your Entry must be framed. A stretched canvas is considered a framed work. It is imperative that your entry has "D" Rings ; attached for hanging. "D" Rings should be no more than ten (10) cm from the top of the artwork.
Delivery of Works	The Entry will only be accepted if accompanied by an Entry Form. (LATE ENTRIES (after 4.00 pm) WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. NO EXCEPTIONS. Curatorial/Selection of works entered	The major prize-winners and a selection of entrants work will be displayed from Saturday TBC This selection is at the discretion of the Curator of Shoalhaven City Arts Centre. Works cannot be removed from the exhibition until the end of the exhibition.
Sale of Artworks	Sale of Artwork is optional. Shoalhaven Regional Gallery will charge 25% commission on all sales. Please include this commission into the price of your artwork. GST is the responsibility of the Entrant.
Insurance/liability	Exhibitors must arrange their own insurance. All care will be taken but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage prior to, during, or after the Exhibition. It is a condition of entry that all art entered into the exhibition can be safely hung and no danger of injury to the public.
Presentation of Awards	Awards will be presented at the Exhibition launch commencing at 2pm Saturday 29 April 2023 in the Shoalhaven Regional Gallery.

Hanging Guide for Your Artwork.

- *Your entry must be ready for hanging or display
- * Your entry/work must be an original work of the exhibitor.
- *No Diptychs or Triptychs will be accepted.
- *Only one physical framed artwork will be accepted.
- *Wet paintings or unsafe works will NOT be accepted.
- *Your entry must be framed. A stretched canvas is considered a framed work as long as it has D rings.

It is imperative that your work has "D" Rings attached hanging (See below).

Triangle shaped "D" Rings should be no more than ten (10) cm from the top of the Work. (See below images). Triangle shaped "D" Rings are to be NO SMALLER THAN 15mm at the broadest edge of the base of the "D" Ring. String is NOT required between the "D" Rings.

"D" rings can be purchased from local hardware stores or your picture framer.
